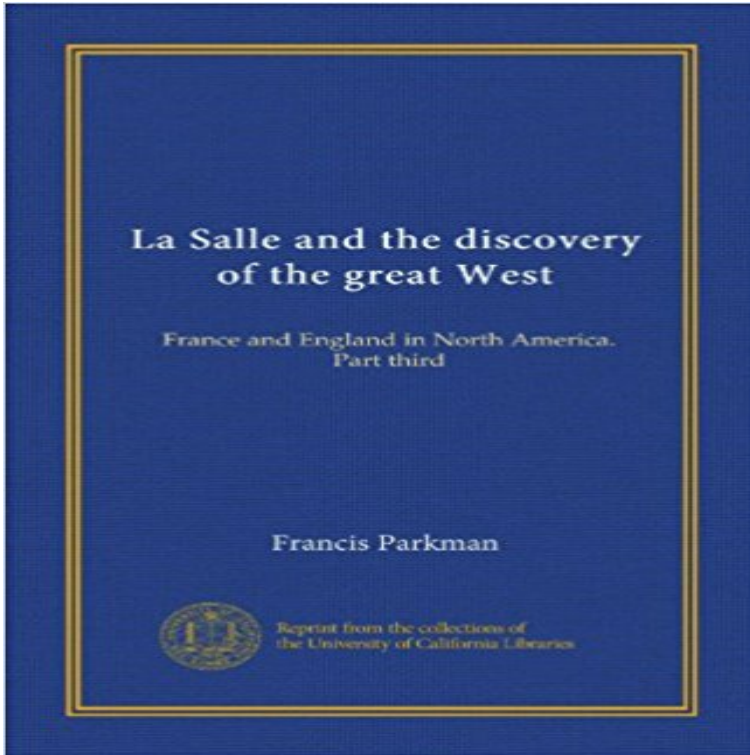


La Salle and the discovery of the great West (v.2): France and England in North America. Part third
