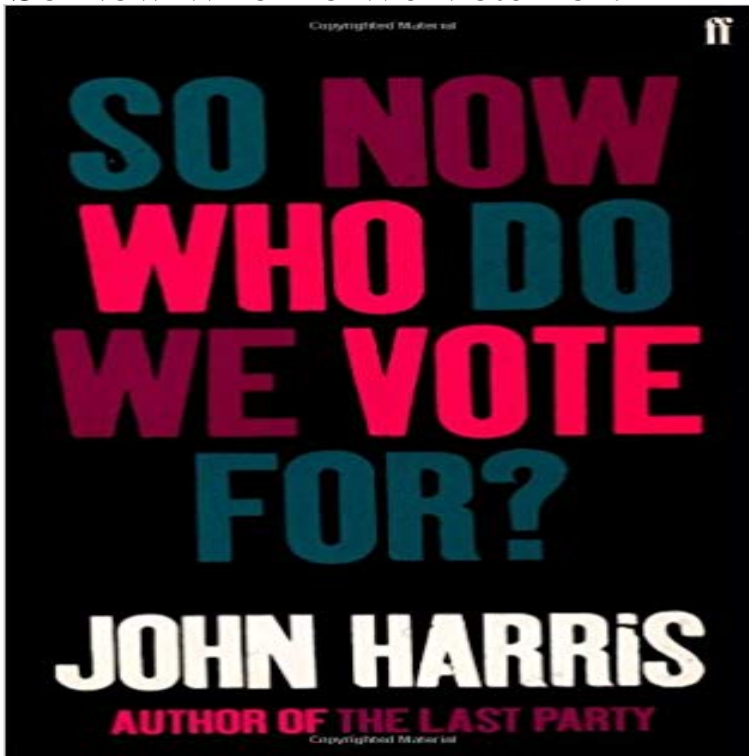


So Now Who Do We Vote For?
