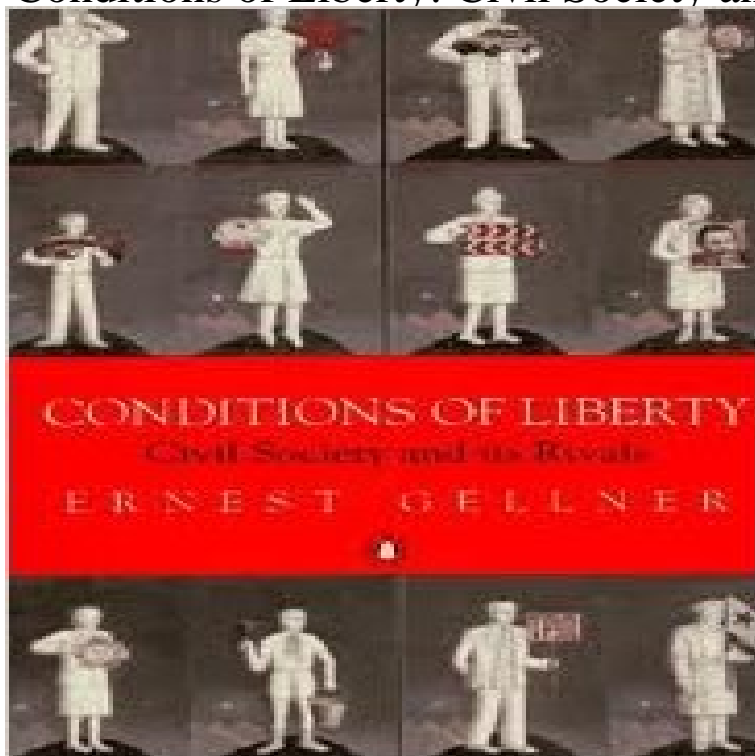


Conditions of Liberty: Civil Society and Its Rivals
