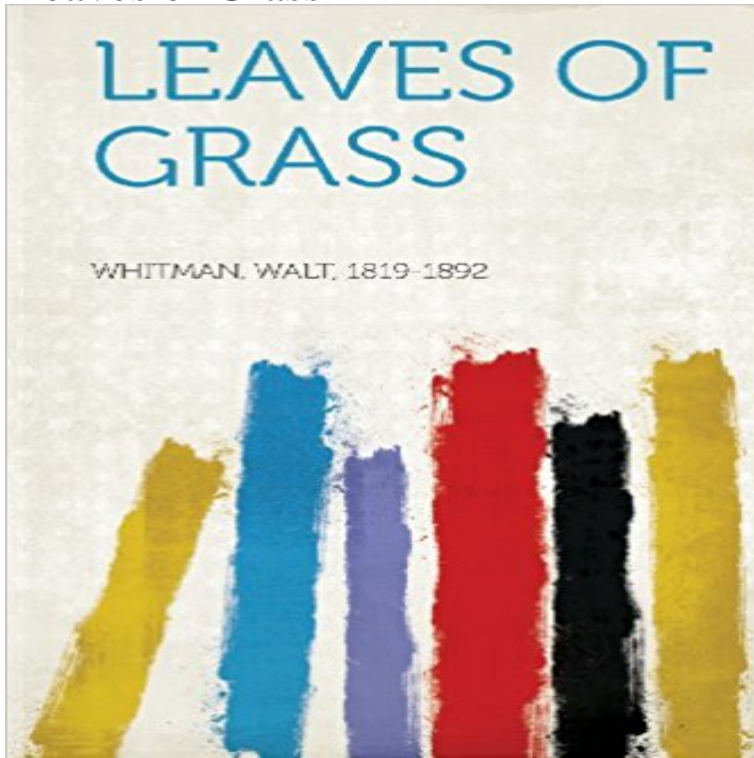


Leaves of Grass
