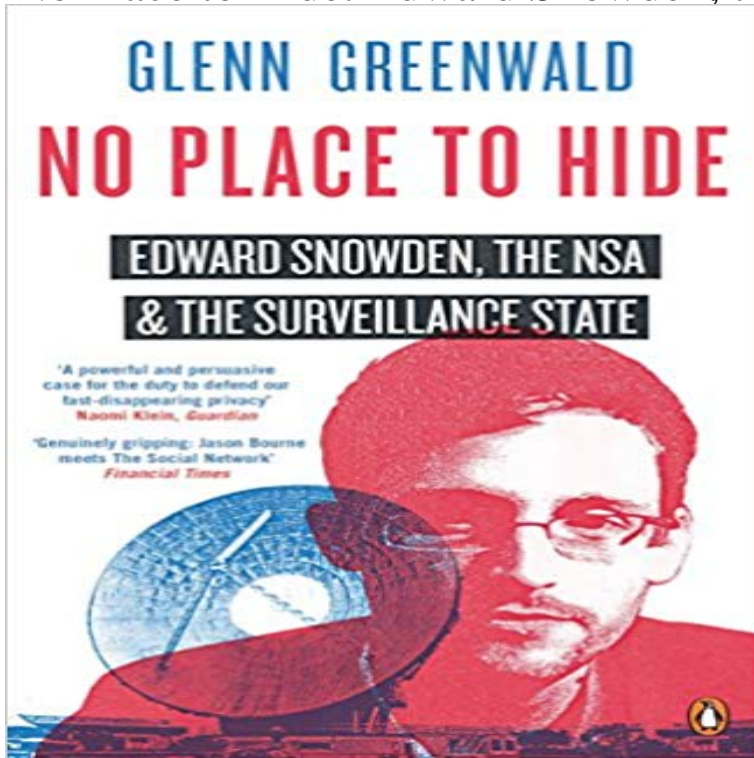


No Place to Hide: Edward Snowden, the NSA and the Surveillance State
