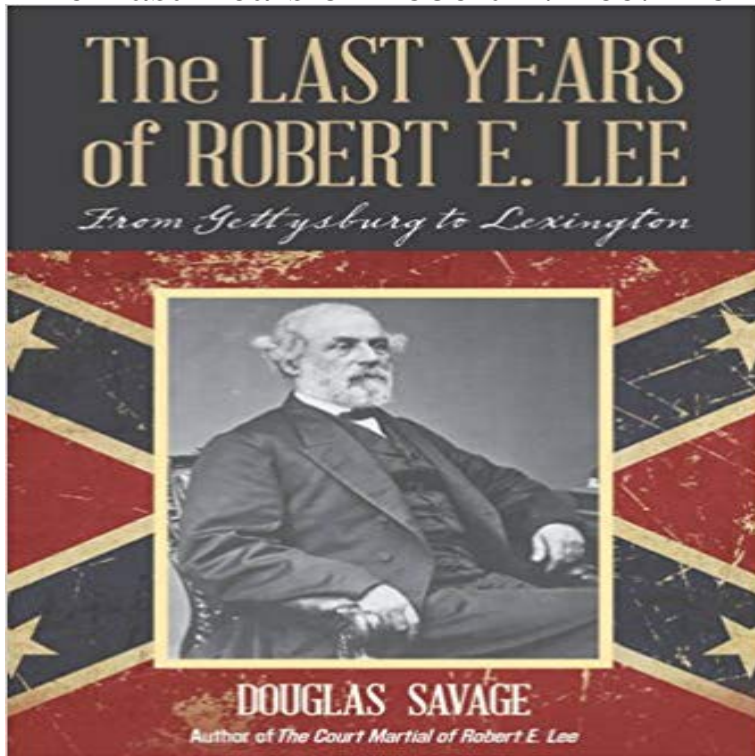


The Last Years of Robert E. Lee: From Gettysburg to Lexington
